INVITATION TO SUBMIT EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT OF A SCHEME TO RECOGNISE AND PROMOTE EXCELLENCE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF C&D WASTE

The National Construction and Demolition Waste Council (NCDWC) was established and approved by the Minister of the Environment in June 2002. The Council was set up as a Voluntary Industry Initiative with the role of providing a framework to achieve compliance with the policy and targets for recycling of construction and demolition (C&D) waste as set out in the Government policy document, "*Changing our Ways*".

The Council proposes to establish an industry wide scheme to recognise and promote excellence in the management of C&D waste. It is anticipated that the scheme would also provide an incentive for the construction industry to adopt Best Practice with regard to waste management.

The Council invites "Expressions of Interest" from interested parties to establish, develop and manage this project on behalf of the NCDWC. Following receipt of "Expressions of Interest" the Council will engage in dialogue with all interested parties to develop and expand on the details of the scheme.
